Groves Cabin Theatre in Morongo Valley is presenting **“When Life Gives You Lemons Make Lemonade,”** a series of short one-act plays featuring **“Lemonade”** by James Prideaux. The series will play Saturday evenings and Sunday afternoons from February 23 – March 22.

Playwright Prideaux's theme in **“Lemonade”** is the desperation with which we seek to evade the mundane, the illusions small people live by, and the emptiness that can exist beneath the thin veneer of supposed well-being. The perceptive and witty one-act play focuses on Jan Miner and Nancy Coleman, a pair of Peoria matrons who seek respite from the doldrums of middle age by selling spiked lemonade to highway travelers. The dialogue is hilarious as the two trade drinks and the fantasies they have concocted to brighten their dull lives.

Each show in the series will highlight **“Lemonade”** plus additional short one-act plays that will vary at each performance. The individual plays in the series are directed by popular Groves regulars Marge Doyle, Steve Fuji, and Vicki Montgomery and feature the acting talents of Kathy Colgin, Mike Dorrington, Marge Doyle, Steve Fuji, Joy Groves, Ken Lindsey, Vicki Montgomery and Ralph Simmons.

Groves Cabin Theatre (<http://www.grovescabintheatre.org/>) has won multiple Desert Theatre League awards for its high-quality productions. The 23-seat theater offers one of the most intimate theatrical experiences available anywhere in the world—that experience having been described as being “like a fly on the wall, witnessing real life happening before my eyes.” **The limited seating means early reservations are a must.**

“When Life Gives You Lemons Make Lemonade” will be performed each Saturday evening at 8:00 PM and Sunday afternoon at 2:30 PM from Saturday, February 23, through Saturday, March 22. **Groves Cabin Theatre** is located at 8768 Desert Willow Trail in Morongo Valley north of Highway 62 (look for the large red, white, and blue stone on the north side of the highway).
